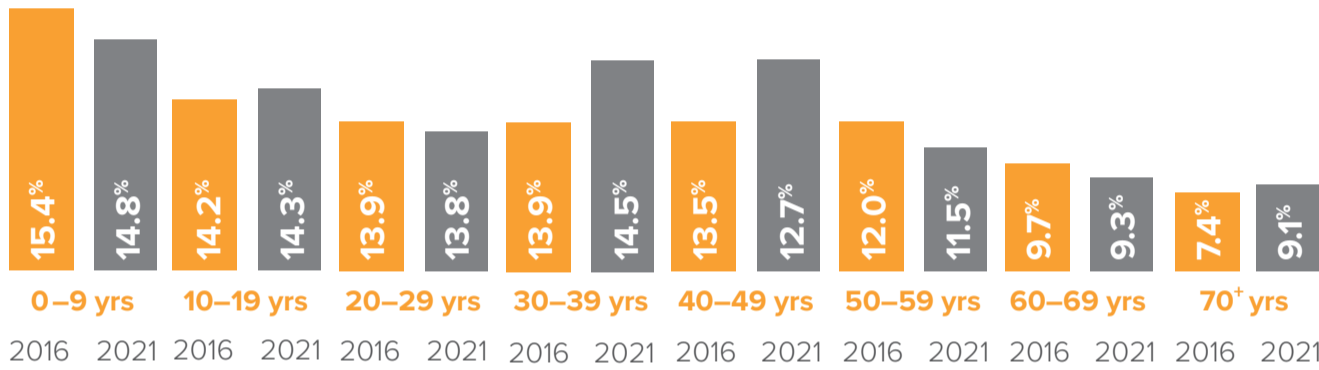

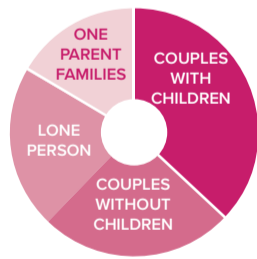

(Down from 38.2%)



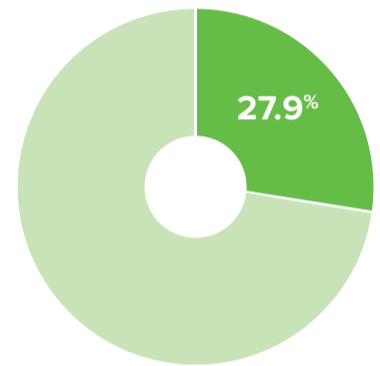
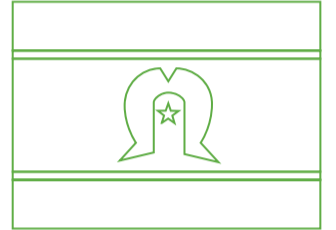
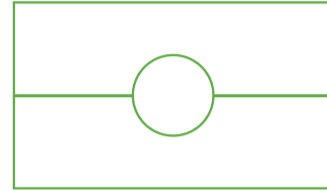

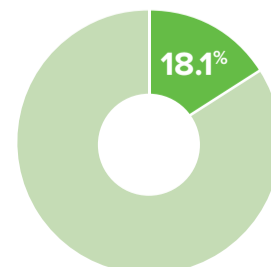
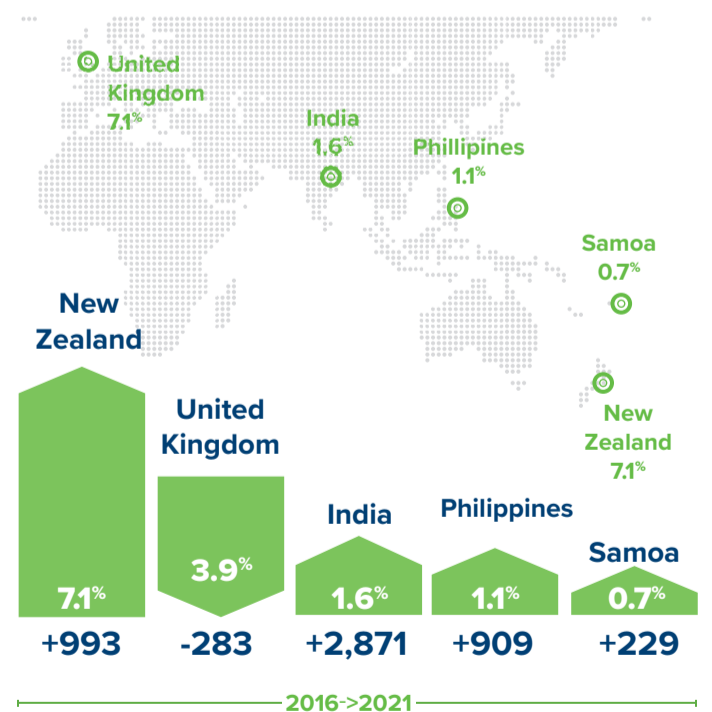
CULTURAL DIVERSITY

TOP 5 COUNTRIES where people were born outside of Australia are:

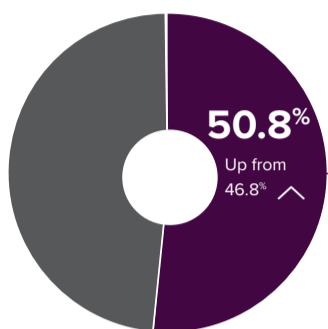


Persons that spoke a **LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH** at home increased from 15.9% to **18.1%**

CAR OWNERSHIP:

There is an average of **2 motor vehicles per household**

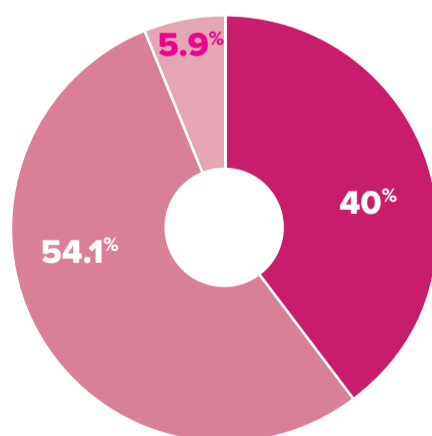


More households **own 3 or more motor vehicles**

EMPLOYMENT LOCATION OF RESIDENT WORKERS



- Live and work in the area
- Live in the area, but work outside
- No fixed place of work

JOURNEY TO WORK:

Travel to work by public transport DECREASED from 5.9% to **3.2%**

Work from home increased from 3.7% to **10.7%**

The 2021 Census was during the Covid-19 pandemic, which has had an impact on work and travel behaviour.

Travel to work by car as driver DECREASED from 69.7% to **66.5%**

Due to population increases though it still meant an extra 8,935 cars/people on the roads.
